ePACT Network

Youth and teen camp registrations require completion of online waivers, emergency contact/authorized pickup, and medical info via ePACT. After registering, families will receive an email from ePACT to setup or reconfirm their child's account. This step is crucial for full registration and your child's participation. Drop-Off/Pick-Up

Arrival activities are an important component of the daily schedule. Arriving promptly to camp ensures that your child can fully participate in the arrival sequence and also reduces disruptions. **Note: In the event of inclement weather, please check the Homeroom App for updates on camp drop-off/pick-up.**

Monday/Wednesday/Friday:

Drop-Off (8:00-8:15am) – Century Park Pavilion (1401 Indianwood Drive)

Pick-Up (2:50-3:00pm) – Century Park Pavilion (1401 Indianwood Drive)

Tuesday/Thursday:

Drop-Off (8:00-8:15am) – Sullivan Community Center (635 N. Aspen Drive) – Walnut Room

Pick-Up (2:50-3:00pm) – Sullivan Community Center (635 N. Aspen Drive) – Walnut Room

A parent/guardian or authorized individual must sign your camper in/out of camp each day. To expedite this process, have a state ID or Driver's License ready for staff. Campers with walking/biking permission indicated in ePACT may sign themselves in/out.

If you arrive more than 15 minutes after camp begins, please call the Camp Director to sign-in and then escort your child to their camp group's location. **On field trip days, all campers must arrive by 8:30am.** Field trip buses must adhere to their schedules and will not delay for late arrivals.

Camp Groups & Homeroom Application

Stay up to date on camp happenings! Camp staff will post an overview of the day's activities, photos, announcements, and reminders on the Homeroom App on a regular basis. The Homeroom App can be downloaded to your mobile phone or accessed online. The access code is provided on your registration receipt.

If you need to reach camp staff or have questions/concerns, please contact camp directly via email or by phone during camp hours (8am-3pm). We appreciate your feedback and don't want it lost amongst comments on the Homeroom App.
